What We Do

Red Rovers is a 'family like' football club designed to fill a gap in the provision of matchplay opportunities in the locality of the Strettons.

This season we are trying to build up player numbers and enter teams in the South Shropshire Under 8, 9, 11 and 13 leagues mainly to ensure continuity and sufficient quantity of games. **Please remember** the league results themselves are not so as important as the regular opportunity to play matches that the league provides. We aim to run a training session on Tuesdays (for U8/U10) straight after school, from 3.30-4.30pm (September-May inc) Fridays 6.00-7.30 for U11-U13, and Summer Soccer Sessions on Wednesdays during June/July from 6.00-7.30pm. We may train indoors during November to February or outdoors under floodlights.

How We Do It

Our philosophy is to create match playing opportunities for those who might otherwise go without that experience. We want to give everyone a chance to develop their skills and experience - not just rely on the gifted few! This is why we ensure **ALL** players have a chance to play, whatever their standard. No one gets left out and match/pitch time is shared between available players. Our approach rewards commitment - anyone available to play and committed to the team will be equally involved in the matches played wherever possible and with a fair amount of playing time*.

This inclusive policy gives everyone a chance to develop and ultimately, given time, encouragement and patience, will lead to more rounded, skilful and stronger teams and players. And perhaps, just as important, is the friendship and community encouraged amongst the players themselves – giving them another interest outside of school and home.
