

HOW IT WORKS (IN BRIEF)

Red Rovers is run by parents for the benefit of their children. We encourage parents to attend matches and training/practice sessions to watch, support or help. It's your team you can get involved.

SECURITY

Red Rovers are affiliated to the Shropshire Football Association with the benefits of its public liability insurance cover. In addition we have player injury insurance under the same scheme. (document can be seen on-line)

FEES

There is a £10 registration/joining fee with Red Rovers thereafter you only pay for each match played. Currently match fees are £1 per game.

TRAINING & PRACTICE

We run U8-U10 'training' on Tuesdays from 3.30-4.30pm, and U11-U13 on Fridays from 6.00-7.30pm, in Church Stretton, September-May.

MATCHES

We arrange friendly matches as and when we can, there is no set day or time. We also play in the South Shropshire League on Weekend mornings or afternoons (U8s/U9s, & U11s/U13s). Everyone attending matches gets to play! Subject to quantity of players enrolled in each squad you may not need to attend every match – giving players and parents a chance of a break. We do encourage parents to help with travel to away matches and/or share the load as required.

KIT

Red Rovers will supply team shirts, shorts and socks for matches. Currently players will need to supply raincoat, shinguards and football boots. For training players will supply their own kit in any format. In ALL cases shinguards must be worn or no activity can be permitted.

COMMUNICATION

The Red Rovers website (www.redrovers.org.uk) and email is your main source of information, particularly as arrangements can alter at a late stage (e.g. match cancellation). Please check regularly, especially on a Friday evening or when weather might affect a fixture. Parts of the website are private and protected for members only – a password will be provided for you. *Please inform the Secretary if you cannot access the website or use it as a main communications tool.*

HELP

All parents are encouraged to help with the running of the club – please speak to a member of the volunteer staff, team managers or committee we would like to use your skills, support and enthusiasm where we can.
