

Code of Conduct for Players

Obligations to the Game

A player should:

- Make every effort to develop their skills, technique, tactics and stamina.
- Give maximum effort and strive for the best possible performance during a game.
- Set a positive example to others.
- Not use inappropriate or foul language.

Obligations to Your Club

A player should:

- Make every effort consistent with fair play and the laws of the game.
- Resist any influence that might question their commitment to the team.
- Make every effort to ensure attendance at training sessions.
- Make every effort to be available for matches.
- Encourage other members of your team on and off the pitch.
- Ensure officials are informed of unavailability or attendance problems.
- Take good care of any equipment or kit belonging to the club.

Respect for the Laws of the Game and Competition Rules

A player should:

- Know and abide by the laws, rules and spirit of the game.
- Accept success and failure, victory and defeat equally.
- Resist any temptation to take banned substances or use banned techniques.

Respect towards opponents

A player should:

- Treat opponents with respect at all times.
- Safeguard the well being of opponents, avoid violence and rough play, and help injured opponents.

Respect towards Match Officials, Team Officials and Supporters

A player should:

- Accept the decision of the match official without protest.
- Avoid words or actions which may mislead a match official.
- Show respect to match officials.
- Show respect to club officials.
- Pay attention and cooperate during training sessions.
- Abide by the instructions of their coach provided they do not contradict the spirit of this code.
- Show respect to team officials of your opposition.
- Show respect to the interests of supporters.

Failure to abide by the code could lead to action from the club and ultimately to suspension from matches or cancellation of membership.
